Question: What are the advantages of using CNG and LPG as fuels? Answer:- The advantages of using CNG and LPG as fuels are as follows:

- *i.* they are easily transported through pipes and filled in cylenders.

## Explain the process of formation of petroleum.

**Answer:-** Petroleum forms from organisms living in the sea. As these organisms died, their bodies settled at the bottom of the sea and got covered with layers of sand clay. Over millions of years, absence of air and high temperature transform the dead organisms into petroleum and natural gas.
